

ORDER PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS ON CERTAIN LOTS IN SUBDIVISIONS LOCATED IN GRIMES COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Commissioners Court that there is concern for public safety arising from various instances involving the discharge of firearms in certain areas of Grimes County; and

WHEREAS, after conducting a public hearing with regard to same, the Court deems it necessary, in order to promote the public safety of citizens in Grimes County, Texas, to regulate such activity; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Grimes County, Texas, is authorized by Statute to prohibit or otherwise regulate the discharging of firearms in certain areas within said County;

NOW, THEREFORE, under the authority granted by Section 240.022 of the Texas Local Government Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the discharge of firearms on lots that are 10 acres or smaller that are located in the unincorporated areas of Grimes County, Texas, in a Subdivision, is hereby prohibited.
